Locking your phone



All Mobile phones have a power button.

The button is usually on top but can also be on the side

If you are finished using your phone you can press this button to turn the screen off.

This locks the phone and turns your screen off.



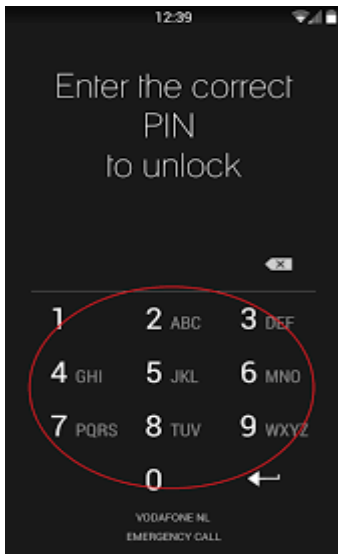
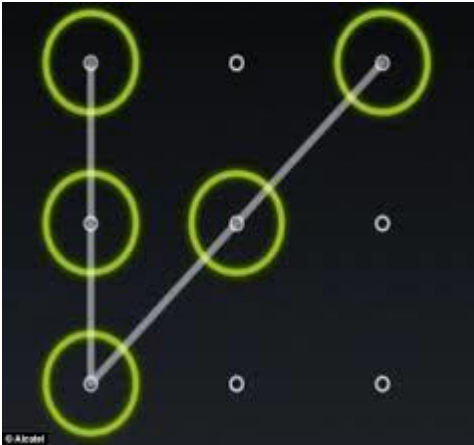
Unlocking your phone

Locking your phone is important for security reasons.

To unlock your phone you can set a 4 number password or you can draw a pattern.

On some newer phones you can even use your fingerprint.

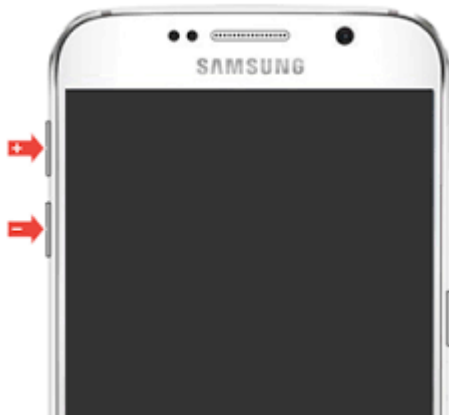


Volume



All Phones have volume buttons on the side.

You can adjust this up and down to make the ringtone quieter or louder.



Or to make your music or video quieter or louder.

Text size

If you find the text on your screen difficult to see or read you can increase the size of the writing.

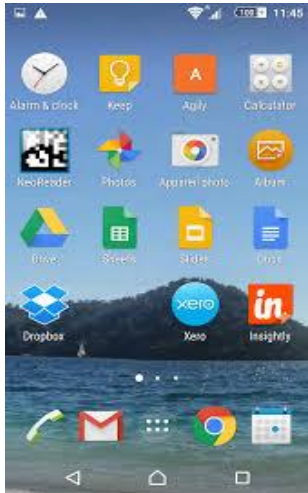
On some phones you can even have the phone read what's on the screen to you.

Sometimes your phone comes with lots of Apps and the screen can get very cluttered and messy looking.

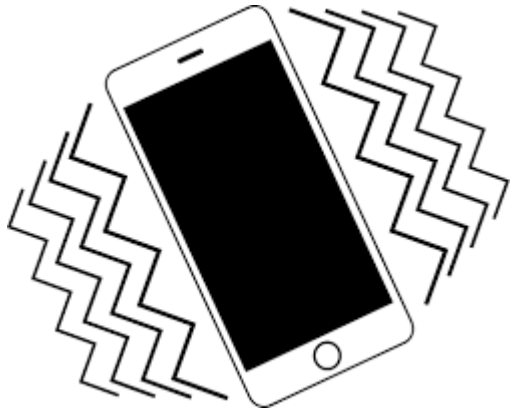


You can move all these Apps around or even move them to a different page.

You can even have a different ringtone for different people.

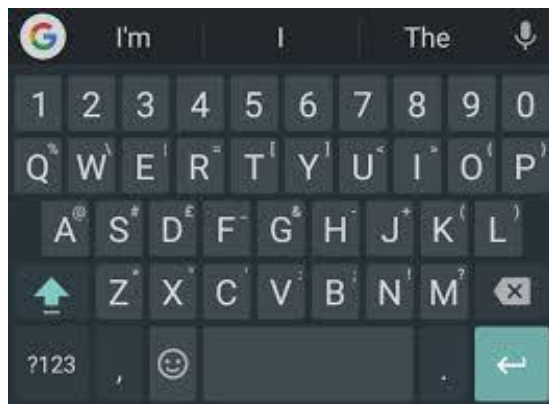
You can also change your notification sounds and how hard your phone vibrates.

Keyboard
